

(A) AT LEAST ANNUALLY, THE HEALTH OFFICER FOR A COUNTY SHALL BE EVALUATED, IN WRITING, BY THE SECRETARY AND BY THE COUNTY.

(B) THE GOVERNING BODY OF EACH COUNTY SHALL ESTABLISH BY ORDINANCE OR RESOLUTION THE PROCESS BY WHICH THE COUNTY EVALUATES THE HEALTH OFFICER.

(C) THE SECRETARY SHALL ESTABLISH BY RULE OR REGULATION THE PROCESS BY WHICH THE SECRETARY EVALUATES THE HEALTH OFFICERS.

(D) THE SECRETARY AND THE COUNTY EACH SHALL REVIEW THEIR RESPECTIVE EVALUATIONS OF A HEALTH OFFICER WITH THE HEALTH OFFICER.

51C.

A HEALTH OFFICER OR DEPUTY HEALTH OFFICER WHO IS A PHYSICIAN MAY NOT:

(1) PRACTICE MEDICINE, EXCEPT IN THE PERFORMANCE OF OFFICIAL DUTIES WHEN LICENSED AS A PHYSICIAN IN THIS STATE; OR

(2) ENGAGE IN ANY OCCUPATION THAT CONFLICTS WITH THE PERFORMANCE OF OFFICIAL DUTIES.

THE HEALTH OFFICER FOR A COUNTY SHALL HAVE AN OFFICE LOCATED AT AN ACCESSIBLE PLACE IN THE COUNTY.

51E.

(A) IN ADDITION TO THE POWERS AND DUTIES SET FORTH ELSEWHERE, EACH HEALTH OFFICER HAS THE POWERS AND DUTIES SET FORTH IN THIS SECTION.

(B) THE HEALTH OFFICER FOR A COUNTY IS THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND SECRETARY OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH.

(C) THE HEALTH OFFICER FOR A COUNTY SHALL APPOINT THE PERSONNEL OF THE COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT.

(D) (1) A HEALTH OFFICER FOR A COUNTY SHALL ENFORCE THROUGHOUT THE COUNTY:

(I) UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE SECRETARY, THE STATE HEALTH LAWS AND THE POLICIES, RULES, AND REGULATIONS THAT THE SECRETARY ADOPTS; AND

(II) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH, THE RULES AND REGULATIONS THAT THE COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH ADOPTS.
