

(2) OTHER AFFILIATED INSTITUTIONS AS APPROPRIATE BECAUSE OF THE SPECIALIZED NATURE OF THE SERVICES TO BE PERFORMED.

(D) GENERAL LICENSE TO PRACTICE DENTAL HYGIENE.

(1) WHILE IT IS EFFECTIVE, A GENERAL LICENSE TO PRACTICE DENTAL HYGIENE ISSUED UNDER THIS TITLE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO PRACTICE DENTAL HYGIENE:

(I) ONLY UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A LICENSED DENTIST WHO IS ON THE PREMISES AND AVAILABLE FOR PERSONAL CONSULTATION WHILE THE SERVICES ARE BEING PERFORMED; AND

(II) ONLY IN A:

1. DENTAL OFFICE;
2. DENTAL CLINIC;
3. HOSPITAL;
4. SCHOOL;
5. CHARITABLE INSTITUTION; OR
6. HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION CERTIFIED BY THE STATE INSURANCE COMMISSIONER.

(2) THE BOARD MAY WAIVE THE SUPERVISION REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBSECTION FOR A DENTAL FACILITY OWNED AND OPERATED BY THE FEDERAL, STATE, OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT IF THE FACILITY APPLIES TO THE BOARD AND SHOWS GOOD CAUSE FOR THE WAIVER.

(E) TEACHER'S LICENSE TO PRACTICE DENTAL HYGIENE.

WHILE IT IS EFFECTIVE, A TEACHER'S LICENSE TO PRACTICE DENTAL HYGIENE ISSUED UNDER THIS TITLE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO:

(1) TEACH DENTAL HYGIENE ONLY AT THE INSTITUTION NAMED ON THE LICENSE; AND

(2) PRACTICE DENTAL HYGIENE UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A LICENSED DENTIST WITH THE INSTITUTION NAMED ON THE LICENSE.
