health officers and county health officers shall hold the office of health officer, as created by this Act, notwithstanding any qualifications for office set under this Act and without taking the oath of office required under this Act and may continue to hold office unless removed in accordance with this Act.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland (as enacted by Chapter 775 of of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1980) be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 21 - Procurement
