

(2) A TEMPORARY LICENSE ISSUED TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS AUTHORIZED TO PRACTICE LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSING IN ANOTHER STATE AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO PRACTICE LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSING IN THIS STATE WHILE THE TEMPORARY LICENSE IS EFFECTIVE.

(C) (1) A TEMPORARY LICENSE MAY NOT BE RENEWED.

(2) UNLESS THE BOARD REVOKES A TEMPORARY LICENSE, EACH TEMPORARY LICENSE EXPIRES 60 DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF ISSUE.

(A) IF A NURSING ADMINISTRATOR, REGISTERED NURSE, OR LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSE KNOWS OF AN ACTION OR CONDITION THAT MIGHT BE GROUNDS FOR ACTION UNDER § ~~7-312~~ 7-313 OF THIS TITLE, THE NURSING ADMINISTRATOR, REGISTERED NURSE, OR LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSE SHALL REPORT THE ACTION OR CONDITION TO THE BOARD.

(B) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO ACTS WITHOUT MALICE IS NOT CIVILLY LIABLE FOR MAKING A REPORT AS REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

AN ACT concerning

Practice of Registered Nursing
