7-101.

- (h)[(1) "Practice registered nursing" means to perform an act that requires substantial specialized knowledge, judgment, and skill based on principles of biological, physiological, behavioral, or sociological science to:
  - (i) Maintain health;
  - (ii) Prevent illness; or

(iii) Care for or rehabilitate the ill, injured, or infirm.

- (2) "Practice registered nursing" includes:
- (i) As to the health needs and health care action capabilities of individuals, families and communities:
  - 1. Assessment;
  - Problem identification;
  - Planning;
  - 4. Implementation; and
  - Evaluation:
- (ii) The administration, the supervision, the delegation, and the evaluation of nursing practice;
  - (iii) Teaching nursing;
- (iv) Performing autonomously or in collaboration with other health team members:
