

(1) SET FORTH THOSE ITEMS THAT MAY BE CREDITED TO OR DISBURSED FROM AN ACCOUNT UNDER THIS SECTION; AND

(2) SET FORTH PROCEDURES FOR CARRYING OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, INCLUDING PROCEDURES THAT PROVIDE DUE PROCESS OF LAW TO ANY INMATE BEFORE HIS ACCOUNTS MAY BE CHARGED WITH A DISBURSEMENT UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.

CHAPTER 287

(Senate Bill 465)

AN ACT concerning

Retail-Service-Stations Motor Fuel Inspection
Law - Moratorium on Conversion of Service Stations

FOR the purpose of ~~continuing--a--certain~~ extending the moratorium on the conversion of existing ~~retail~~ service stations to gasoline-only facilities,--and--including certain--stations--in-the-moratorium ;--providing--that--a certain-restriction--does--not--apply--upon--a--certain agreement,--requiring-certain-actual-relationships to--conferm--to--the--Maryland--Gasohol--and--Gasoline Products---Marketing---Act,---removing---a---certain consideration,--adding-grounds--for--certain-penalties, and---correcting---language- repealing certain considerations relating to certain service stations; authorizing the Comptroller to suspend or revoke certifications of registration for violations of this Act for periods lasting until the violations are corrected; and relating generally to the moratorium on the conversion of existing service stations to gasoline-only facilities.
