- (6) THE ANNUAL SALARY FOR THE COUNSEL TO THE BOARD IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY SHALL BE AS PROVIDED IN THE BUDGET OF ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY , BUT SHALL NOT BE LESS THAN THE SALARY OF A BOARD MEMBER.
- SECTION 2. AND-BE-IT-FURTHER-ENACTED, That-this-Act may-not-be-construed-to-extend-or-apply-to-the-salary-of-the counsel-to-the-Election-Board-of-Anne-Arundel--Gounty--in office-on-the-effective-date-of-this-Act,-but-the-provisions of-this-Act-concerning--the-salary--of-the-Anne-Arundel Gounty-Election-Board's-counsel-shall--take--effect--at--the beginning-of-the-next-following-term-of-office:

(Senate Bill 536)
