FOR the purpose of removing automotive dismantlers and recyclers from the definition of "automotive graveyard" and "junkyard" in Title 8, Subtitle 8 of the Transportation Article; altering the definition of "junkyard"; defining the term "automotive dismantler and recycler facility"; altering certain sections of Title 8, Subtitle 8 the Code so that automotive dismantler and recycler facilities are continued to be regulated and licensed in the same manner as they currently are; and generally relating to the regulation licensing of automotive dismantler and recycler facilities.
