SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

4-102.

(b) Notwithstanding any [other local or] general [law] OR LOCAL LAWS OR ORDINANCES TO THE CONTRARY, [in Charles and St. Mary's counties the catching of fish is legal if it is] FINFISH, CRABS, OYSTERS, CLAMS, AND OTHER SHELLFISH, caught in the WATERS WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE POTOMAC RIVER FISHERIES COMMISSION, in compliance with [the provisions of] REGULATIONS PRESCRIBED BY THE COMMISSION PURSUANT TO the Potomac River Compact [and any rule or regulation adopted by the Potomac River Commission] OF 1958, MAY BE POSSESSED, STORED, MARKETED, AND OTHERWISE DISPOSED OF ELSEWHERE IN THE STATE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.
