publication in the Register and the date fixed in the notice for the hearing, FOR THE MEETING, or for the termination of the opportunity to be heard is:

- (1) Not less than the time specifically prescribed for the publication of the notice by law, or
- (2) Not less than 15 days if no time for publication is specifically prescribed by law, without prejudice, however, to the effectiveness of any notice of {less than} 5-TO 15 days when it is reasonable.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.

## CHAPTER 330

(Senate Bill 984)

AN ACT concerning

Alcoholic Beverages - Special and Temporary Licensees - Baltimore City

FOR the purpose of providing that special-and-temporary license-holders-need-not-purchase-beer-and-light-wine from--retail--dealers in Baltimore City the holder of a Class C special beer, wine, and liquor license may purchase beer and light wine from a wholesale dealer.
