that create the office of the Commissioner of Consumer Credit and relate to the duties and powers of the Commissioner are of no effect and may not be enforced after [July 1, 1982] JULY 1, 1988.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Policy Committee of the General Assembly shall undertake a study of the Act and shall report to the General Assembly by December 1, 1981. The study shall include an evaluation of the quality and effectiveness of the evaluation performed under this Act, the implementation of the recommendations made by the Department of Fiscal Services, and the legislative committees, and the impact of the Act on the General Assembly.

SECTION 2 $\underline{3}$. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.

CHAPTER 368

(House Bill 496)

AN ACT concerning

Collection Agency Licensing Board

FOR the purpose of continuing the existence of the State Collection Agency Licensing Board in accordance with the Regulatory Programs Evaluation Act (sunset law) by extending to a certain date the termination provisions relating to the statutory and regulatory authority of this agency and the regulation of collection agencies; and requiring a study of the "sunset" law to be conducted.
