- (i) A written section on the sciences taught in preclinical courses, including:
 - Anatomy;
 - Bacteriology;
 - Chemistry;

- (ii) A written or oral section on clinical
 subjects, including:
 - 1. Chiropractic principles;
 - 2. Chiropractic technique and

- 3. Hygiene;
- 4. Neurology;
- Orthopedics;
- 6. Physical diagnosis;
- Roentgenology;
- 8. Symptomatology; and
- 9. Physical therapy, as defined in § 13-101 of this article.

Subject to the hearing provisions of § 3-311 of this subtitle, the Board may deny a license to any applicant, reprimand any licensee, or suspend or revoke a license if the applicant or licensee:

- (1) Practices chiropractic without having been issued an annual renewal certificate as required by this title;
- (2) Fraudulently or deceptively obtains or attempts to obtain a license for the applicant or licensee or for another;
 - (3) Fraudulently or deceptively uses a license;
