

or improper disposal. These facilities shall be located subject to the following considerations:

(10) [That where after due consideration for the geological stability of a location and any possible effects to a public or private water supply become known, the facility site may not be used.] THAT THERE IS DUE CONSIDERATION FOR THE GEOLOGICAL STABILITY OF A LOCATION AND FOR THE SAFETY AND PRESERVATION OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE WATER SUPPLIES. IF THE LOCATION OF A FACILITY SITE WILL RESULT IN ANY ADVERSE EFFECTS TO A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE WATER SUPPLY, THE FACILITY SITE MAY NOT BE APPROVED.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 81 - Revenue and Taxes
