(House Bill 596)

AN ACT concerning

Driver-Education Driver's License Fees

FOR the purpose of ~~repealing certain provisions of law relating to the termination of State support of the high school driver education program in this State, and generally relating to the continuation of State support of the high school driver education program in this State~~ increasing certain fees for certain driver's licenses.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
