personal consultation while the services are being performed; and

(ii) Only in a:

- 1. Dental office;
- 2. Dental clinic:
- Hospital;
- 4. School;
- 5. Charitable institution; or
- 6. Health maintenance organization certified by the State insurance commissioner.
- (2) The board may waive, ON A FACILITY-BY-FACILITY BASIS ONLY, the supervision requirements of this subsection for a dental facility owned and operated by the federal, state, or local government if the facility applies to the board and shows good cause for the waiver.
- (3) THE BOARD SHALL MAINTAIN IN ITS MINUTES THE CRITERIA OR BASIS FOR GRANTING A WAIVER TO A FACILITY.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.

CHAPTER 421

(House Bill 1105)

AN ACT concerning

Teacher's Retirement - Continuation of Employment

FOR the purpose of providing that a teacher in an optional retirement program may continue employment for a certain period of time after a certain age if the participant follows certain procedures; and relating generally to the continuation of employment by a teacher who has reached a certain age.
