prohibiting transactions with minors; requiring certain dealers to be licensed and providing licensing procedures; providing for certain appeal procedures; providing for circumstances under which a dealer's license may be denied, refused to be renewed, suspended, or revoked; providing for certain forms to be prepared; excluding certain records from the Public Information Article; preempting certain local laws and ordinances; preempting certain local laws relating to numismatic items after a certain date; generally relating to precious metals and gem dealers; and providing that provisions of this Act are severable; and-making-this-Aet-an-emergency-measure.
