- (1) To adopt rules and regulations to carry out the provisions of this title;
- (2) To set standards for the practice of registered nursing and licensed practical nursing;
- (3) To adopt rules and regulations for the performance of [additional acts] DELEGATED MEDICAL FUNCTIONS [that:
- (i) Require formal education and clinical experience or its equivalent; and
- (ii) Are] WHICH ARE recognized jointly by the State Board of Medical Examiners and the State Board of Examiners of Nurses [as proper to be performed by registered nurses], UNDER § 14-304(D) OF THIS ARTICLE;
- (4) To adopt rules and regulations for the performance of additional NURSING acts that:
- (i) May be performed under any condition authorized by the Board, including emergencies; and
- (ii) Require education and clinical experience; [and
- (iii) Are recognized by the State Board of Medical Examiners and the State Board of Examiners of Nurses as proper to be performed by registered nurses or licensed practical nurses;]
- (5) TO ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR REGISTERED NURSES TO PERFORM INDEPENDENT NURSING FUNCTIONS THAT:
- (I) REQUIRE FORMAL EDUCATION AND CLINICAL EXPERIENCE: AND
- (II) MAY BE PERFORMED UNDER ANY CONDITION AUTHORIZED BY THE BOARD, INCLUDING EMERGENCIES;
- [(5)] (6) To adopt rules and regulations for licensed practical nurses to perform additional acts in the practice of registered nursing [;] THAT:
- (I) REQUIRE FORMAL EDUCATION AND CLINICAL EXPERIENCE;
- (II) MAY BE PERFORMED UNDER ANY CONDITION AUTHORIZED BY THE BOARD, INCLUDING EMERGENCIES; AND
- (III) ARE RECOGNIZED BY THE NURSING BOARD AS PROPER FOR LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSES TO PERFORM;
  - [(6)] (7) To keep a record of its proceedings;
