- [(5)] (6) In Harford County the rate is 6 percent per annum or as fixed by resolution of the County Council; [and]
- [(6)] (7) In Howard County the rate is 6 percent
 per annum or as fixed by resolution of the County Council;
 [and]
- [(7)] (8) In Montgomery County the rate is 6 percent per annum or as fixed by resolution of the County Council; [and]
- [(8)] (9) In Prince George's County the rate is 6 percent per annum or as fixed by resolution of the County Council; and
- [(9)] (10) In Somerset, Wicomico, and Worcester counties the rate is 6 percent per annum or as fixed by the county commissioners or by resolution of the county council.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.
