

[(5)] (6) In Harford County the rate is 6 percent per annum or as fixed by resolution of the County Council; [and]

[(6)] (7) In Howard County the rate is 6 percent per annum or as fixed by resolution of the County Council; [and]

[(7)] (8) In Montgomery County the rate is 6 percent per annum or as fixed by resolution of the County Council; [and]

[(8)] (9) In Prince George's County the rate is 6 percent per annum or as fixed by resolution of the County Council; and

[(9)] (10) In Somerset, Wicomico, and Worcester counties the rate is 6 percent per annum or as fixed by the county commissioners or by resolution of the county council.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.
