SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article - Transportation

(a) (1) The Administrator or any other officer or employee of the Administration designated by the Administrator may prepare and deliver on request a certified copy of any record of the Administration.

(2) The Administration may charge a fee of [\$1] \$2 for each document it certifies.

(3) NO CHARGE SHALL BE MADE TO A POLICE AGENCY OR COURT IN THIS OR ANY OTHER STATE OR A POLICE AGENCY OR COURT OF THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT.

(a) (1) Notwithstanding any other provision to the contrary, if, as a result of a total loss insurance settlement, a vehicle is transferred as salvage, the insurance company, its authorized agent, or the vehicle owner shall send the certificate of title of the vehicle to the Administration within 10 days from the date of the settlement.

(2) On payment of a fee of \$2, the Administration shall issue a salvage certificate in the name of the insurance company or vehicle owner. On receipt of the
