- (1) TO ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE;
- (2) TO ADOPT STANDARDS FOR THE PRACTICE OF ELECTROLOGY:
  - (3) TO KEEP RECORDS OF ITS PROCEEDINGS;
- (4) TO KEEP A LIST OF ALL CURRENTLY LICENSED ELECTROLOGISTS AND LICENSED ELECTROLOGY INSTRUCTORS:
- (5) TO SUBMIT AN ANNUAL REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND THE SECRETARY;
- (6) TO ESTABLISH CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS;
- (7) TO REFER TO THE STATE'S ATTORNEY ANY ALLEGED VIOLATION OF THIS TITLE;
- (8) IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET, TO INCUR ANY NECESSARY EXPENSE THAT RELATES TO THE REFERRAL OF AN ALLEGED VIOLATION OF THE CRIMINAL PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE; AND
- (9) TO REVIEW ADVERTISING BY ANY LICENSEE OR ANY INSTITUTION THAT OFFERS A PROGRAM THAT IS APPROVED UNDER THIS TITLE.

5-206. ESTABLISHMENT OF FEES; DISPOSITION OF FUNDS.

## (A) ESTABLISHMENT OF FEES.

- (1) EXCEPT FOR THE FEES SPECIFICALLY SET BY THIS TITLE, THE BOARD MAY SET REASONABLE FEES FOR THE ISSUANCE AND RENEWAL OF LICENSES AND ITS OTHER SERVICES.
- (2) THE FEES CHARGED BY THE BOARD SHALL BE SET SO AS TO PRODUCE FUNDS TO APPROXIMATE THE COST OF MAINTAINING THE BOARD.
  - (B) DISPOSITION OF FUNDS.

THE BOARD SHALL PAY ALL FUNDS COLLECTED UNDER THIS TITLE INTO THE GENERAL FUND OF THIS STATE.
