

(1) TO ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE;

(2) TO ADOPT STANDARDS FOR THE PRACTICE OF ELECTROLOGY;

(3) TO KEEP RECORDS OF ITS PROCEEDINGS;

(4) TO KEEP A LIST OF ALL CURRENTLY LICENSED ELECTROLOGISTS AND LICENSED ELECTROLOGY INSTRUCTORS;

(5) TO SUBMIT AN ANNUAL REPORT TO THE GOVERNOR AND THE SECRETARY;

(6) TO ESTABLISH CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS;

(7) TO REFER TO THE STATE'S ATTORNEY ANY ALLEGED VIOLATION OF THIS TITLE;

(8) IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET, TO INCUR ANY NECESSARY EXPENSE THAT RELATES TO THE REFERRAL OF AN ALLEGED VIOLATION OF THE CRIMINAL PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE; AND

(9) TO REVIEW ADVERTISING BY ANY LICENSEE OR ANY INSTITUTION THAT OFFERS A PROGRAM THAT IS APPROVED UNDER THIS TITLE.

5-206. ESTABLISHMENT OF FEES; DISPOSITION OF FUNDS.

(A) ESTABLISHMENT OF FEES.

(1) EXCEPT FOR THE FEES SPECIFICALLY SET BY THIS TITLE, THE BOARD MAY SET REASONABLE FEES FOR THE ISSUANCE AND RENEWAL OF LICENSES AND ITS OTHER SERVICES.

(2) THE FEES CHARGED BY THE BOARD SHALL BE SET SO AS TO PRODUCE FUNDS TO APPROXIMATE THE COST OF MAINTAINING THE BOARD.

(B) DISPOSITION OF FUNDS.

THE BOARD SHALL PAY ALL FUNDS COLLECTED UNDER THIS TITLE INTO THE GENERAL FUND OF THIS STATE.
