AN APPLICANT WHO OTHERWISE QUALIFIES FOR A LICENSE IS ENTITLED TO BE EXAMINED AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.

(B) TIME AND PLACE OF EXAMINATION.

THE BOARD SHALL GIVE EXAMINATIONS TO APPLICANTS AT LEAST TWICE A YEAR, AT THE TIMES AND PLACES THAT THE BOARD DETERMINES.

(C) NOTICE OF EXAMINATION.

THE BOARD SHALL NOTIFY EACH QUALIFIED APPLICANT OF THE TIME AND PLACE OF EXAMINATION.

- (D) SUBJECTS AND METHOD OF EXAMINATION.
- (1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED UNDER THIS TITLE, THE BOARD SHALL DETERMINE THE SUBJECTS, SCOPE, FORM, AND PASSING SCORE FOR EXAMINATIONS GIVEN UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.
 - (2) EACH EXAMINATION SHALL INCLUDE:
- (I) A SECTION ON THE THEORY OF ELECTROLOGY; AND
- (II) A SECTION ON THE CLINICAL PRACTICE OF ELECTROLOGY.
 - (E) REEXAMINATION.
- (1) AN APPLICANT MAY RETAKE AN EXAMINATION OR A FAILED SECTION OF AN EXAMINATION AFTER PAYING TO THE BOARD A REEXAMINATION FEE OF \$50.
- (2) AN APPLICANT WHO FAILS TWO REEXAMINATIONS MAY RETAKE THE EXAMINATION ONLY IF THE APPLICANT:
 - (I) RETAKES THE ENTIRE EXAMINATION; AND
 - (II) PAYS THE FULL EXAMINATION FEE.
 - (F) PARTICIPATION BY CONSUMER MEMBERS OF THE BOARD.

UNLESS AUTHORIZED BY THE BOARD, THE CONSUMER MEMBERS MAY NOT PARTICIPATE IN ANY ACTIVITY RELATED TO EXAMINATIONS UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.
