

As to subsection (b)(2)(ii) and (iii) of this section, the word "substantially" is added to clarify that an absolute equivalence of qualifications is not required and to conform to the language added in § 5-302(d)(2) of this subtitle.

5-306. SAME -- CERTAIN LICENSES ISSUED BY STATE BOARD OF COSMETOLOGISTS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HELD AN ELECTROLOGIST LICENSE OR AN ELECTROLOGY INSTRUCTOR LICENSE THAT WAS ISSUED BY THE STATE BOARD OF COSMETOLOGISTS AND THAT WAS VALID ON JUNE 30, 1978, IS ENTITLED TO A LICENSE UNDER THIS TITLE WITHOUT EXAMINATION.

(B) CONDITIONS.

THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE A LICENSE UNDER THIS SECTION ONLY IF THE APPLICANT:

(1) IS OF GOOD MORAL CHARACTER; AND

(2) SUBMITTED TO THE BOARD ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 31, 1979:

(I) AN APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE BOARD REQUIRES;

(II) EVIDENCE OF THE PRIOR LICENSE; AND

(III) A LICENSE FEE OF \$50.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from Art. 43, § 555B-19.

Although technically obsolete, this section is retained to avoid any implication that its deletion might cause -- e.g., that an individual licensed under this section would be unable to renew the license.

5-307. ISSUANCE AND CONTENTS OF LICENSE.

(A) ISSUANCE.

THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE A LICENSE TO ANY APPLICANT WHO:

(1) MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS TITLE; AND

(2) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN § 5-306 OF THIS SUBTITLE, PAYS A LICENSE FEE OF \$100.
