(B) CONTENTS.

THE BOARD SHALL INCLUDE ON EACH LICENSE THAT THE BOARD ISSUES A LICENSE DESIGNATION AS:

- (1) AN ELECTROLOGIST LICENSE; OR
- (2) AN ELECTROLOGY INSTRUCTOR LICENSE.

In subsection (a)(2) of this section, the language "{e} xcept as provided in § 5-306 of this subtitle" is added because a different license fee is required under that section.

5-308. SCOPE OF LICENSE.

(A) ELECTROLOGIST LICENSE.

AN ELECTROLOGIST LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO PRACTICE ELECTROLOGY WHILE THE LICENSE IS EFFECTIVE.

(B) ELECTROLOGY INSTRUCTOR LICENSE.

AN ELECTROLOGY INSTRUCTOR LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO PRACTICE ELECTROLOGY AND TO TEACH THE CLINICAL PRACTICE OF ELECTROLOGY WHILE THE LICENSE IS EFFECTIVE.

5-309. TERM AND RENEWAL OF LICENSES.

(A) TERM OF LICENSE.

A LICENSE EXPIRES ON THE OCTOBER 31 AFTER ITS EFFECTIVE DATE, UNLESS THE LICENSE IS RENEWED FOR A 1-YEAR TERM AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.

(B) RENEWAL NOTICE.

AT LEAST 1 MONTH BEFORE THE LICENSE EXPIRES, THE BOARD SHALL SEND TO THE LICENSEE, BY FIRST CLASS MAIL TO THE LAST KNOWN ADDRESS OF THE LICENSEE, A RENEWAL NOTICE THAT STATES:

(1) THE DATE ON WHICH THE CURRENT LICENSE EXPIRES;
