(B) The Council shall advise the Governor[, the Secretary and the Director] on all matters pertaining to [civil defense and disaster preparedness] STATE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND CIVIL DEFENSE. The members of the Council shall serve without compensation, but may be reimbursed for their reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.

(a) The Governor shall have general direction and control of the [Civil Defense and Disaster Preparedness] STATE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND CIVIL DEFENSE Agency, and shall be responsible for the carrying out of the provisions of this subtitle. In the event of [disaster] THE OCCURRENCE OR THREAT OF AN EMERGENCY beyond local control, the Governor may assume direct operational control over all or any part of [the civil defense and disaster preparedness functions] ANY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT FUNCTION [within the State] CREATED OR AUTHORIZED BY THIS ARTICLE. The Governor may delegate such powers as he may see fit to the Secretary of Public Safety and Correctional Services[, and the Secretary may in turn delegate such powers to] OR the Director.

(b) In performing his duties under this subtitle, the Governor [may]:

(1) MAY cooperate with the federal government, with other states, and with private agencies in all matters
