- (j) (1) The State Board shall send the Governor an annual State public school budget including, subject to the State Constitution and existing laws, the appropriation for:
  - (i) The Department; AND
- (ii) State aid to the counties for current expenses, FOR STUDENT TRANSPORTATION and for the construction of school buildings[; and
- (iii) The necessary costs of transporting students to public schools, as the State Board estimates them after considering the recommendations of the State committee on the school bus formula].
- (2) The budget shall be certified by the State Superintendent before it is sent to the Governor.

## 4-119.

- (a) If a county board considers it practicable, it shall consolidate schools.
- (b) [Subject to the approval of the State Superintendent, each] EACH county board shall arrange for the transportation of students to and from consolidated schools.

## 5-201.

- (c) The State Comptroller shall charge against and, as provided in this section, pay from the General State School Fund the following annual appropriations for:
- (1) The support of the department, including the expenses of the State Board and the support and expenses of the office of the State Superintendent;
  - (2) The Maryland Teachers' Retirement System;
  - (3) The education of handicapped children;
  - (4) Subsidized or free feeding programs;
- (5) The administration and supervision of vocational education in public high and vocational schools;
  - (6) Physical education and recreation;
  - [(7) Medical examination of school bus drivers;
- (8)] (7) Case and guidance service for handicapped individuals who need vocational rehabilitation;
  - [(9)] (8) Equivalence examinations;
