department or facility, the court shall grant a hearing for the purpose of determining if the standard in subsection (f) continues to be met. At any time after the commitment of the child to a State mental hospital if the individualized treatment plan developed under Section 3A of Article 59 recommends that a child no longer meets the standards in subsection (f), then the court shall grant a hearing to review the commitment order. The court may grant a hearing at any other time for the purpose of determining if the standard in subsection (f) continues to be met.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.
