

(D) FUNERAL DIRECTOR.

"FUNERAL DIRECTOR" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO PRACTICES FUNERAL DIRECTION.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language added to provide an express definition of "funeral director".

(E) FUNERAL ESTABLISHMENT.

"FUNERAL ESTABLISHMENT" MEANS ANY PLACE FROM WHICH THE PRACTICE OF MORTUARY SCIENCE IS CONDUCTED.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection presently appears as Art. 43, § 361(a).

The present terms "building" and "structure" are deleted as redundant in light of the term "place".

The only other changes are in style.

(F) LICENSE.

(1) "LICENSE" MEANS, UNLESS THE CONTEXT REQUIRES OTHERWISE, A LICENSE ISSUED BY THE BOARD.

(2) "LICENSE" INCLUDES, UNLESS OTHERWISE INDICATED:

(I) A MORTICIAN LICENSE;

(II) AN APPRENTICE LICENSE;

(III) A FUNERAL DIRECTOR LICENSE;

(IV) A SURVIVING SPOUSE LICENSE;

(V) A CORPORATION LICENSE; AND

(VI) A FUNERAL ESTABLISHMENT LICENSE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language added for clarity and to avoid needless repetition of phrases such as "license issued by the Board".

(G) LICENSED APPRENTICE.

"LICENSED APPRENTICE" MEANS, UNLESS THE CONTEXT REQUIRES OTHERWISE, AN APPRENTICE WHO IS LICENSED BY THE BOARD TO ASSIST A LICENSED MORTICIAN IN THE PRACTICE OF MORTUARY SCIENCE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language added to avoid needless repetition of phrases such as "apprentice licensed by the Board".
