SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland  
(as enacted by Chapter 376 of the Acts of the General  
Assembly of 1947) be repealed, amended, or enacted to read  
as follows:

Article 44 - Hospitals - Maryland

[9A.

The State of Maryland shall annually appropriate and  
pay to the County Commissioners of Baltimore County  
commencing and accounting from July 1st, 1949, the sum of  
\$5,487.53 as payment for the cost of sewer service to the  
Spring Grove State Hospital, and proper provision shall be  
made for the appropriations herein in all State budgets  
after the budget for the present biennium from July 1st,  
1947 through June 30, 1949.]

Article 78A - Public Works

54.

(a) [It is the policy of the General Assembly that the  
State is responsible for its share of] THE STATE SHALL PAY  
the annual operating costs of furnishing water and sewer  
service to State buildings and facilities and [for] ITS  
SHARE OF those lateral system construction costs associated  
with future installation of water and sewer lines that  
directly serve the State building or facility.

(b) The Secretary of the Department of General  
Services shall make rules and regulations governing payments  
by the State or any of its agencies or instrumentalities to  
any county, municipality, or special district of water and
