[[i]] (G) "Registered nurse" means, unless the context requires otherwise, an individual who is licensed by the Board to practice registered nursing.

7-205.

In addition to the powers and duties set forth elsewhere in this title, the Board has the following powers and duties:

(1) To adopt rules and regulations to carry out the provisions of this title;

(2) To set standards for the practice of registered nursing and licensed practical nursing;

(3) To adopt rules and regulations for the performance of additional acts that:

(i) Require formal education and clinical experience or its equivalent; and

(ii) Are recognized jointly by the medical and nursing professions as proper to be performed by registered nurses;

(4) To adopt rules and regulations for the performance of additional acts that:

(i) May be performed under any condition authorized by the Board, including emergencies;
