CHAPTER 622

(House Bill 568)

AN ACT concerning

Oysters - Harvest on Leased Oyster Bottoms By Lessee

FOR the purpose of allowing a lessee to harvest leased oyster bottoms in any manner in Dorchester, Charles, Queen Anne's, Kent, and Somerset counties.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:
