

THE TREATMENT OF WASTEWATERS DISCHARGED INTO WATERS OF THE STATE THAT ARE DESIGNATED BY THE DEPARTMENT AS CLASS III, NATURAL TROUT WATERS AND THEIR TRIBUTARIES.

(3) (I) ANY LOCAL SUBDIVISION OWNING OR OPERATING AN EXISTING TREATMENT SYSTEM, WHICH WOULD BE REQUIRED TO CONVERT FROM USE OF CHLORINATION TO ANOTHER SYSTEM IN ORDER TO BE PERMITTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, SHALL APPLY, BY SEPTEMBER 30, 1982 1981, TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR ECONOMIC ASSISTANCE IN CONVERSION.

(II) IF THE LOCAL SUBDIVISION MAKES SUCH APPLICATION, THE CONVERSION COSTS NOT FUNDED BY THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY SHALL MAY BE COVERED WITH STATE FUNDS AS PROVIDED IN THE BUDGET. ~~THE--STATE--FUNDS NECESSARY--TO--COMPLY--WITH--THE--PROVISIONS--OF--THIS--PARAGRAPH SHALL--BE--INCLUDED--IN--THE--1983--STATE--BUDGET.~~

(III) IF THE LOCAL SUBDIVISION FAILS TO APPLY BY SEPTEMBER 30, 1982 1981, CONVERSION COSTS NOT ORDINARILY MET BY THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY AND THE STATE SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE SUBDIVISION.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is contingent on the availability of matching Federal funds to implement the provisions of Section 8-1413(m)(3)(i) of the Natural Resources Article, as enacted by this Act.
