certain conditions to the use of eminent domain; and providing for the termination of this Act on a certain date.

Charter of Baltimore City Article II - General Powers Section (15A)(a) (1964 Revision, as amended)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article II - General Powers

(15A) INDUSTRIAL AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

(a) To acquire, within the boundary lines of Baltimore City, land and property of every kind, by purchase, gift, EMINENT-BOMAIN, or any other legal means [, but not by eminent domain,] for or in connection with the industrial and economic growth of Baltimore City. HOWEVER, THE USE OF EMINENT DOMAIN FOR THIS PURPOSE SHALL BE LIMITED TO ACQUISITION OF ADJACENT BUT NOT NECESSARILY CONTIGUOUS LAND AND PROPERTY OF EVERY KIND TO BE USED FOR OR IN CONNECTION WITH THE EXPANSION, DEVELOPMENT, OR REDEVELOPMENT OF INDUSTRIAL PARKS IN BALTIMORE CITY CONTAINING 150 ACRES OR MORE WHICH ARE OR WERE ASSEMBLED, OWNED, OR DEVELOPED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE;

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981. The changes made by this Act shall remain effective through January 31, 1982, and at the end of January 31, 1982, and with no further action required by the General Assembly, the changes made by this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect. The abrogation of this Act, however, shall not affect any suit or suits at law filed pursuant to this Act on or before January 31, 1982.
