FOR the purpose of establishing a 3 year limitation for commencing a contempt-of-court action against a parent in default on court-ordered child support or against a spouse in default on court ordered spousal support.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:
