certain conditions and restrictions on the sale and disposition of products and services of State Use Industries; providing for the use, management, and reporting of funds by the State Use Industries; providing for legislative approval of the State Use Industries budget and manpower allocations; providing that, with certain exceptions, certain positions shall be subject to the State Merit System; and generally relating to the State Use Industries the work related training of inmates, and the production of goods and provision of services by inmates.

STATE USE INDUSTRIES ACT

680.

THE PURPOSE OF THIS ACT IS TO CREATE WITHIN THE DIVISION OF CORRECTION, A STATE USE INDUSTRIES ORGANIZATION, WHICH:

(1) (I) IS FINANCIALLY SELF SUPPORTING;

(II) GENERATES REVENUE FOR ITS OPERATIONS AND CAPITAL INVESTMENT;

(III) REASONABLY REIMBURSES FOR THE SERVICES EXCHANGED BETWEEN THE DIVISION AND STATE USE INDUSTRIES; AND
