## CHAPTER 667

(House Bill 1063)

AN ACT concerning

Smoke Detectors - Installation and Maintenance

FOR the purpose of requiring occupants of residential units to equip and maintain the units with smoke detectors by a certain date; establishing certain investigation procedures and a certain penalty for violation of a certain provision of this Act relating generally to the installation and maintenance of smoke detectors; requiring specialized smoke detectors for the deaf and hearing impaired; and removing obsolete language.
