CHAPTER 686

(House Bill 1385)

AN ACT concerning

Allegany County - Alcoholic Beverages - Sunday Delivery

FOR the purpose of providing that in Allegany County a licensed beer wholesaler may deliver draft beer to a licensed retailer on Sundays; authorizing the wholesaler and retailer to agree as to a fee to be charged for the use of equipment provided by the wholesaler; and providing that the act of furnishing equipment is not in violation of the enticement law.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:
