SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland (as enacted by Chapter \_\_\_\_\_ (H.B. 1) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1981) be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article - Health Occupations

4-305.

(a) An applicant who otherwise qualifies for a general license to practice dentistry or a general license to practice dental hygiene is entitled to be examined as provided in this section.

(b) The Board shall give examinations to applicants twice a year, at the times and places that the Board determines.

(c) The Board shall notify each qualified applicant of the time and place of examination.

(d) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the Board shall determine the subjects, scope, form, and passing score for examinations given under this title.

(2) To the extent the Board finds practicable, the examination given to applicants for a general license to practice dentistry shall be in writing.

(e) Unless authorized by the Board, the consumer members of the Board may not participate in any ~~activity~~ ACTIVITY related to examinations under this Title.

(F) UNLESS AUTHORIZED BY THE BOARD, A DENTAL HYGIENIST MEMBER OF THE BOARD MAY NOT PARTICIPATE IN ANY ACTIVITY RELATING TO THE EXAMINATION OF DENTISTS UNDER THIS TITLE.

[(a) The dental hygienist member of the Board may vote only on matters that directly affect dental hygienists.]
