Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

14A.

- (a) Section 14 of this article does not apply to an officer of a corporation appearing in the District Court on behalf of that corporation in a civil suit involving a claim not exceeding [\$500] \$1,000 and not based upon an assignment to the corporation of the interest of another.
- (b) This section applies notwithstanding any Maryland District Rule to the contrary.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.
