(House Bill 1855)

AN ACT concerning

Worcester County - Alcoholic Beverages (Ocean City Convention Hall Commission)

FOR the purpose of permitting a Class D license be issued to the Ocean City Convention Hall Commission; and granting certain monopolistic privileges to the Commission with eertain-restrictions; and-limiting-the-yearly-number-of Class-B-licenses-that-may-be-issued-to-certain-bonafide nonprefit--erganizations--using--the--convention--hall; respect to alcoholic beverages, while permitting the Commission to allow, with certain restrictions, certain nonprofit organizations and the Mayor and City Council, when using the Convention Hall, to bring alcoholic beverages onto the Hall's premises, without being issued any type of alcoholic beverages license; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Worcester County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

(y) [(8) (i) In Worcester County, the license shall be issued only within the tenth election district.

(ii) The annual fee for the license is \$750.
