(A) THE FOLLOWING STATE AGENCIES SHALL COOPERATE IN ASSISTING THE SECRETARY IN EVALUATING ANY TECHNOLOGY OR MEANS FOR THE PERMANENT DISPOSAL OF LOW-LEVEL NUCLEAR WASTE:

(1) THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES;

(2) THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION;

(3) THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT;
