- (3) (I) THE TREASURER MAY NOT INVEST STATE FUNDS IN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT INVESTMENT POOL MAY-BE-GONSOLIBATED WITH-STATE-FUNDS-UNDER-THE-GONTROL-OF-THE-TREASURER-FOR INVESTMENT-PURPOSES-PROVIDED-THAT-ASCURATE-AND-BETAILED ACCOUNTING-RECORDS-ARE-MAINTAINED-FOR-THE-FUNDS-OF-EACH PARTICIPATING-LOCAL-GOVERNMENT-AND-THAT-A-PROPORTIONATE AMOUNT--OF--INTEREST-EARNED-IS-GREDITED-TO-THE-LOCAL GOVERNMENT-INVESTMENT-POOL-AND-THE-ACCOUNTS-THEREIN.
- (K) (J) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE ONLY EITHER (1) WHEN FUNDS ARE APPROPRIATED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OR OTHERWISE BECOME AVAILABLE TO DEFRAY THE INITIAL COSTS IN ESTABLISHING THE POOL AUTHORIZED BY THIS SECTION; OR
- (2) AT A TIME DESIGNATED BY THE FISCAL AGENT PROVIDED FOR IN SUBSECTION (H) OF THIS SECTION.
- (L)--FOR---THE---PURPOSE---OF---THIS---SECTION,--"LOCAL COVERNMENT"--INCLUDES--A--COUNTY,--BALTIMORE--CITY,---OR---A MUNICIPAL-CORPORATION-
- (K) FUNDS PLACED IN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT INVESTMENT POOL MAY NOT BE CONSIDERED TO BE TREASURY FUNDS.
- (L) FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "LOCAL GOVERNMENT" INCLUDES ALL OF THE LEGAL ENTITIES, BODIES, AND AGENCIES SET OUT IN SECTION 22 OF THIS ARTICLE, EXCEPT THE STATE AND AGENCIES OF THE STATE.
