board of county commissioners or the county council does not oppose the issue of the permit.

The provisions of this section relating to sludge composting facilities do not apply to sites with permits pending with the Department before June 1, 1979.

(B) IN CHARLES AND ST. MARY'S COUNTIES, THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION APPLY TO THE ENTRENCHING, STORAGE, OR TRANSPORTATION OF SLUDGE EMANATING FROM A PRIVATE, COMMERCIAL, OR MUNICIPAL WASTE WATER TREATMENT PLANT NOT LOCATED IN THE RESPECTIVE COUNTY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.

(Senate Bill 981)

AN ACT concerning

Flood Control and Watershed Management
