- INCURRED BY GRAIN PRODUCERS ON GRAIN WHICH THE GRAIN PRODUCERS HAVE DELIVERED TO GRAIN BUYERS.
- (B) THERE IS AN INDEMNIFICATION ADMINISTRATION FUND WHICH IS ESTABLISHED FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING THE EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE INDEMNIFICATION PROGRAM PROVIDED FOR IN THIS TITLE.
- (C) THE FUNDS CREATED BY THIS SECTION SHALL BE ADMINISTERED BY THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE.

- (A) (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAKE AN ASSESSMENT OF 2 5 MILLS PER BUSHEL ON ALL GRAIN DELIVERED BY GRAIN PRODUCERS TO GRAIN BUYERS.
- BUYER WHO DOES BUSINESS IN THIS STATE WHERE DELIVERY IS IN FACT TO THAT BUYER.
- (3) THE GRAIN BUYER SHALL REMIT THE AMOUNT OF THE ASSESSMENT TO THE DEPARTMENT AS PROVIDED IN THIS SUBTITLE.
- (B) GRAIN MAY NOT BE SUBJECT TO THE ASSESSMENT MORE THAN ONCE.
- (C) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, WHEN THE FUND REACHES \$2,000,000, THE 2 5 MILL ASSESSMENT PROVIDED FOR IN THIS SUBTITLE SHALL CEASE.
- (2) IF THE FUND REACHES \$2,000,000 BETWEEN JULY 1 AND JUNE 30, THE ASSESSMENT SHALL CONTINUE UNTIL JUNE 30.
- (D) THE 2 5 MILL ASSESSMENT SHALL BE REINSTATED AS NECESSARY TO MAINTAIN A BALANCE OF \$2,000,000 \$5,000,000 IN THE FUND.
- (E) THE DEPARTMENT MAY INVEST AND REINVEST MONEY CONTAINED IN THE FUND. ANY PROCEEDS FROM SUCH INVESTMENT SHALL BE ADDED TO THE FUND.
