- (c) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the State share is 50 percent of the current expenses of each community college, but not more than -{-\$850-}- \$895 per full-time equivalent student, EXCEPT THAT FOR FISCAL YEAR 1982 ONLY THE STATE SHARE SHALL NOT EXCEED \$878 PER FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT STUDENT.

- (i) Any community college with less than 500 full-time equivalent students if the county in which the community college is located has a population of less than 50,000; and
