SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That for fiscal year 1982 only and from only those funds provided by the sale of abandoned property as provided by Section 2 of this Act, and from no other funds, and, subject to the provisions of law relating to budgetary procedure to the extent applicable, the amounts specified below, or as much as is required to accomplish the designated purpose, is hereby appropriated and authorized to be disbursed from as much of the revenues as are received by the State from the proceeds of the sale of abandoned property as provided by Section 2 of this Act:

36.12.00.02 Aid to Community Colleges:

In addition to the amount appropriated in the Budget Bill for fiscal year 1982, the following amounts are to be used for funding as specified:

General Fund Appropriation....\$5,631,000.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the effectiveness of this Act is contingent upon the passage of either House Bill 1298 or Senate Bill 948 of 1981. If neither of these bills should be passed, the provisions of this Act are null and void without the need of further action by the General Assembly.

SECTION-2:--AND-BE-IT-FURTHER-ENACTED;-That-this-Act-is contingent--upon--an--appropriation--contained-in-the-Budget Bill-for-fiscal-year-1982-adequate-to-fund-the--increase--in the--State's--share--formula--for-community-colleges;-and-if said-appropriation-is-net-made-in-the-Budget-Bill;-this--Act shall--be--null--and--void--without-the-necessity-of-further action-by-the-General-Assembly;

SECTION -3-- $\underline{5}$. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions of Section 2 $\underline{4}$ above, this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.
