(3) (1) The funds provided by subsection (e)(1) and (2) do not require a local contribution. [and may not supplant county funds; the State Superintendent of Schools shall establish procedures to assure that the funds do not supplant county funds] THE FUNDS PROVIDED BY SUBSECTION (E)(2) (1) SHALL BE PROVIDED TO EACH SUBDIVISION IF THAT SUBDIVISION APPROPRIATES LOCAL FUNDS TO THE SCHOOL BUDGET IN AN AMOUNT NO LESS THAN THE PRODUCT OF THE FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT ENROLLMENT USED IN CALCULATING FISCAL YEAR 1982 CURRENT EXPENSE AID TIMES THE FISCAL YEAR 1981 LOCAL CONTRIBUTION ON A PER PUPIL BASIS.
