~~(a) In §§ 8-417.1 through 8-417.6 of this subtitle, the following words have the meanings indicated.~~

~~(b) (1) "Basic cost", as to each county, means the average amount spent by the county from county, State, and federal sources for the public education of a nonhandicapped child.~~

~~(2) "Basic cost" does not include amounts specifically allocated and spent for identifiable compensatory programs for disadvantaged children.~~

~~(c) "County board", if appropriate, includes the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City.~~
