

(4) IS CONVICTED OF:

(I) A FELONY; OR

(II) ANY OTHER CRIME OF MORAL TURPITUDE, IF THE OFFENSE BEARS DIRECTLY ON THE FITNESS OF THE INDIVIDUAL TO BE LICENSED;

(5) WILLFULLY AND KNOWINGLY:

(I) FILES A FALSE REPORT OR RECORD OF AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER THE LICENSEE'S CARE;

(II) GIVES ANY FALSE OR MISLEADING INFORMATION ABOUT A MATERIAL MATTER IN AN EMPLOYMENT APPLICATION;

(III) FAILS TO FILE OR RECORD ANY HEALTH RECORD THAT IS REQUIRED BY LAW;

(IV) OBSTRUCTS THE FILING OR RECORDING OF ANY HEALTH RECORD AS REQUIRED BY LAW; OR

(V) INDUCES ANOTHER PERSON TO FAIL TO FILE OR RECORD ANY HEALTH RECORD AS REQUIRED BY LAW;

(6) KNOWINGLY DOES ANY ACT THAT HAS BEEN DETERMINED BY THE BOARD, IN ITS RULES AND REGULATIONS, TO EXCEED THE SCOPE OF PRACTICE AUTHORIZED TO THE INDIVIDUAL UNDER THIS TITLE;

(7) RENDERS REGISTERED NURSING, LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSING, OR MIDWIFERY SERVICES TO A PATIENT WHILE THE APPLICANT OR LICENSEE IS INTOXICATED OR UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF DRUGS;

(8) DOES AN ACT THAT IS INCONSISTENT WITH GENERALLY ACCEPTED PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS IN THE PRACTICE OF REGISTERED NURSING, LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSING, OR MIDWIFERY;

(9) IS GROSSLY NEGLIGENT IN THE PRACTICE OF REGISTERED NURSING, LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSING, OR MIDWIFERY; OR

(10) HAS VIOLATED ANY PROVISION OF THIS TITLE.

(B) RETURNING LICENSES IF SUSPENDED OR REVOKED.

AN INDIVIDUAL WHOSE LICENSE HAS BEEN SUSPENDED OR REVOKED BY THE BOARD SHALL RETURN THE LICENSE TO THE BOARD. HOWEVER, IF THE SUSPENDED OR REVOKED LICENSE HAS BEEN LOST, THE INDIVIDUAL SHALL FILE WITH THE BOARD A VERIFIED STATEMENT TO THAT EFFECT.
